### THE FISHER HOUSE FOUNDATION



A Fisher House is "a home away from home" for families of patients receiving medical care at major military and VA medical centers. The homes are normally located within walking distance of the treatment facility or have transportation available. There are 84 Fisher Houses located on 25 military installations and 35 VA medical centers. Many more houses are under construction or in design. Typically, the houses are 5,000 to 16,800 square foot homes donated by the Fisher family and Fisher House Foundation. Each house is designed to provide 8 to 21 suites. All are professionally furnished and decorated in the tone and style of the local region. The houses can accommodate 16 to 42 family members. They feature a common kitchen, laundry facilities, spacious dining room and an inviting living room with library and toys for children. Newest houses are 100% handicap accessible and include elevators. A Fisher House is a temporary residence and is not a treatment facility, hospice or counseling center. The program began in 1990, and has offered more than 8 million days of lodging to more than 350,000 families.

Fisher House Foundation ensures that there is never a lodging fee. Since inception, the program has saved military and veterans' families over \$451 million in out of pocket costs for lodging and transportation. Over 335,000 families have stayed at a Fisher House since 1990, and that number continues to grow each year as Fisher House Foundation builds new houses at VA and military medical centers with the greatest need.

Fisher House Foundation also operates the Hero Miles program, using donated frequent flyer miles to bring family members to the bedside of injured service members, Thanks to your generosity, we have provided more than 70,000 tickets to wounded, injured, and ill service members and their families, worth over

\$105 million. The Hotels for Heroes program uses donated hotel points to allow family members to stay at hotels near medical centers without charge. The Foundation also manages a grant program that supports other military charities and scholarship funds for military children, spouses and children of fallen and disabled veterans with over \$24 million awarded to date.

"Having a Fisher House on our Perry Point campus fits in perfectly with our model of patient- and-family-centered care," said Dr. Adam M. Robinson, director of the VA Maryland Health Care System. "The new Fisher House will be available to family members and caregivers of veterans receiving care at the Baltimore and Perry Point VA Medical Centers, and the Loch Raven VA Community Living & Rehabilitation Center."







