### The Kisher House Foundation





A Fisher House is "a home away from home" for families of patients receiving medical care at major military and VA medical centers. The homes are normally located within walking distance of the treatment facility or have transportation available. There are 92 Fisher Houses located on 25 military installations and 35 VA medical centers. Many more houses are under construction or in design. Typically, the houses are 5,000 to 16,800 square foot homes donated by the Fisher family and Fisher House Foundation. Each house is designed to provide up to 21 suites. All are professionally furnished and decorated in the tone and style of the local region. The houses can accommodate 16 to 42 family members. They feature a common kitchen, laundry facilities, spacious dining room and an inviting living room with library and toys for children. Newest houses are 100% handicap accessible and include elevators. A Fisher House is a temporary residence and is not a treatment facility, hospice, or counseling center.

Fisher House Foundation ensures that there is never a lodging fee. Since inception, the program has saved military and veterans' families an estimated \$547 million in out-of-pocket costs for lodging and transportation. Over 430,000 families have stayed at a Fisher House since its inception in 1990, and that number continues to

grow each year as Fisher House Foundation builds new houses at VA and military medical centers with the greatest need.

Fisher House Foundation also operates the Hero Miles program, using donated frequent flyer miles to bring family members to the bedside of injured service members. Thanks to your generosity, we have provided more than 80,000 tickets to wounded, injured, and ill service members and their families, worth over \$105 million. The Hotels for Heroes program uses donated hotel points to allow family members to stay at hotels near medical centers without charge. The Foundation also manages a grant program that supports other military charities and scholarship funds for military children, spouses, and children of fallen and disabled veterans with over \$35 million awarded to date.

#### GOLD STAR SISTER REFLECTS

Christina Larsen and her family got one of the worst calls that a military family can receive. Her brother, Air Force Capt. Ryan Phaneuf, had been flying as the co-pilot in an E-11A aircraft in Afghanistan when an engine failure led to him and the other pilot perishing in a crash. Her family was invited to Dover Air Force Base, Delaware, to meet Ryan's remains as he returned to U.S. soil.

"Last year, my brother was serving out in Afghanistan," Christina said, "and we found out that his plane went down, and he and the other pilot didn't survive.

So, we were then told to go to the airport. The military figured it all out. They hooked us up with flights and everything."

During this difficult time, families also have a very special place to stay that was built just for this mission, the Dover Fisher House for Families of the Fallen. The Phaneuf family went there at the same time as the family of the other pilot, Lt. Col. Paul Voss.

"I don't think, if we never went to Fisher House, we would even know who the Voss Family is," Christina said. "But for our circumstance where, you know, it was just my brother and this other pilot, you have people that are going through the exact same thing. And oddly enough, that makes the best friends. I mean, we all still talk to them. I have them on Facebook, I know one of his daughters just graduated college. We've met up with them at Arlington Cemetery in Virginia as well as a dedication memorial in Georgia. That's all because of the Fisher House."

Christina appreciated how the house staff balanced giving the families space while also helping where appropriate.

#### HERO OF FORT HOOD SHOOTING

Pat was working in his office, trying to wrap up his Wednesday afternoon and get back home when he learned that there was an active shooter on base. He went to get the other soldiers nearby to shelter in his office, which was behind two sets of doors with locks, but the first soldier he tried to save turned out to be the shooter. He was hit inches from his heart and spleen. Still, after getting away, he fought through the pain and kept finding soldiers and sending them back to his office where they would be safer.



When he was evacuated to emergency surgery, Pat's wife, Ashley, worked to alert his parents, eventually reaching Pat's mom as she ate dinner with a friend. Pat's siblings and in-laws rushed to be by his side. John and his wife arrived at the base a few days later, while Pat was still in the ICU but was expected to make a full recovery. When they arrived, they were surprised by the Fort Hood Army Fisher House at the Carl R. Darnall Army Medical Center.


"We felt so cared for and respected and felt like we were being treated as family members, that it was first-class accommodations," John said.

"It was good for me to have them there," Pat said, "just to have them see me and so I could see them, to make sure that they were taken care of."

Both Pat and his parents had good reason to be worried about each other. Pat was still recovering from the shooting, and his mother was fighting multiple sclerosis. But the amenities at Fisher House, the professionals at the medical center, and the hospitality of Fort Hood allowed all of them to know that everyone was safe.

### CANCER FIGHT LANDS AIR FORCE FAMILY IN FISHER HOUSE

Throughout the Fall, lan, his wife, Kimberly, their two teenagers, Cydney and Noah, and toddler, Gwyndolyn, settled into their new home.

Kimberly felt worn out but attributed this to the stress of the move. By November, however, things had gotten worse. She was starting to get clumsy, she was forgetful, and she even fell. At this point, they knew it was more than fatigue.



The initial diagnosis was Multiple Sclerosis, but an MRI confirmed it was actually a very rare brain tumor. The neurosurgeon they met with recommended treatment at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center, where Kimberly could receive not only the surgery she needed, but also the longer-term support for recovery.

They received this diagnosis on December 20. Things began happening very quickly. The family of five packed two suitcases each and traveled to Bethesda, Maryland where they were welcomed into the Bethesda Fisher House.

On January 10, Kimberly and Ian met with her new neurosurgeon at WRNMMC and in early February, she underwent an extensive two-day surgery to remove the tumor. Then the long recovery process finally began during which she would receive 30 treatments of radiation therapy to reach what couldn't be removed during surgery.

"Being here at the Fisher House was great because we could just walk to the hospital," said lan. "She had multiple appointments every week with physical training, speech therapy, and working on her vestibular and cognitive abilities."












### Perry Point House

"The new Fisher House will be available to family members and caregivers of veterans receiving care at the Baltimore and Perry Point VA Medical Centers, and the Loch Raven VA Community Living & Rehabilitation Center."

### Scholarship Cash Call



Fisher House Foundation, Inc., an IRS recognized 501(c)(3) charity, administers the Scholarships for Military Children program. Commissary business partners and others donate to Fisher House Foundation, Inc., which treats each contribution as a "restricted donation." Fisher House Foundation, in turn, contracts with "Scholarship Managers," a professional scholarship management firm, to evaluate the applications and select the best qualified as recipients.

Every dollar received is given out as a scholarship grant. Additionally, Fisher House Foundation matches all donations, dollar for dollar, and does not charge for its services, to include the costs of administration and the cost of the scholarship management contract. For school year 2022-23, there will be 500 recipients selected, and each will receive a \$2,000 scholarship grant.

The chair... leans forward against the table and represents a reserved space for each of our heroes.


Please take a moment this evening to remember these brave men and women who have made "the ultimate sacrifice."
