THE FISHER HOUSE FOUNDATION



A Fisher House is "a home away from home" for families of patients receiving medical care at major military and VA medical centers. The homes are normally located within walking distance of the treatment facility or have transportation available. There are 94 Fisher Houses located on 25 military installations and 35 VA medical centers. Many more houses are under construction or in design. Typically, the houses are 5,000 to 16,800 square foot homes donated by the Fisher family and Fisher House Foundation. Each house is designed to provide up to 21 suites. All are professionally furnished and decorated in the tone and style of the local region. The houses can accommodate 16 to 42 family members. They feature a common kitchen, laundry facilities, spacious dining room and an inviting living room with library and toys for children. Newest houses are 100% handicap accessible and include elevators. A Fisher House is a temporary residence and is not a treatment facility, hospice, or counseling center.

Fisher House Foundation ensures that there is never a lodging fee. Since inception, the program has saved military and veterans' families an estimated \$575 million in out-of-pocket costs for lodging and transportation. Over 455,000 families have stayed at a Fisher House since its inception in 1990, and that number continues to grow each year as Fisher House Foundation builds new houses at VA and military medical centers with the greatest need.

THE FISHER HOUSE FOUNDATION

Fisher House Foundation also operates the Hero Miles program, using donated frequent flyer miles to bring family members to the bedside of injured service members. Thanks to your generosity, we have provided more than 70,000 tickets to wounded, injured, and ill service members and their families, worth over \$105 million. The Hotels for Heroes program uses donated hotel points to allow family members to stay at hotels near medical centers without charge. The Foundation also manages a grant program that supports other military charities and scholarship funds for military children, spouses, and children of fallen and disabled veterans with over \$27 million awarded to date.

VETERAN MOM SAYS MARINE SON WAS MIRACLE CHILD

If you talk to Army veteran Pat Sherrod-Elliott about her son, Marine Sgt. Sean Joseph Victor, she tells you, "Our son was actually a miracle."

Sean served eight years in the Marine Corps, traveling to Haiti after a catastrophic earthquake, doing a tour on USS Truman, and living in Japan for two years. He married another service member and had a son.



It was only after his service and starting his own family that Sean and his mother learned he had a genetic disease that usually kills its victims as children.

"When I saw him, I immediately thought that he had had a stroke because he had a different look about him."

Genetic testing eventually revealed ALD, or Adrenoleukodystrophy. The condition damages the membrane that protects the nerve cells in the brain. People born with ALD usually do not make it through childhood, which is what made Sean's case a miracle. It never affected him through his military career.

Pat stayed in the Fisher Houses in Charleston and Bethesda while supporting her son.

"I did not want to travel back and forth every day. It was truly a blessing to have the opportunity to be here in Charleston," she said.

At the Fisher House in Charleston, Pat said she did not have to worry about transportation or meals. It helped her to focus on her son's needs.

"It gave me peace of mind because if I had to travel every day, I think I probably would've lost it because of the stress of his condition," she said, "not knowing exactly what it was, how it was going to affect him, how long it was going to last, what kind of treatment he would need."

FISHER HOUSE IMPACT

AIR FORCE FAMILY SUPPORTS BROTHER WOUNDED IN AFGHANISTAN

August O'Niell's family is filled with service members and veterans. He and his brother are Air Force pararescuemen and his mom, dad, and stepdad are all Air Force veterans, so the family knew the risk of getting the call that no one wants.

Still, they all remember where they were when they got the news that August, while attempting to pull a wounded soldier out of a firefight, suffered leg wounds from a burst of machinegun fire in Afghanistan.



Robert was able to get news that his brother was alive, but it was bad. His unit immediately got him a flight to Landstuhl, Germany for him to be with August.

As a pararescueman, he had some medical knowledge and, when he saw the leg wounds, knew that August was in for a tough recovery. He sent news back to the family and, exhausted, settled into the hospital room to be close to his brother. He even presided over August's re-enlistment in the hospital. He stayed there for about two days, sleeping in the chair before being told about Fisher House.

"I'm sitting there, concerned about what August's life is going be like after this. When I initially heard Fisher House, I didn't know what that was. I honestly initially just thought 'We're going to the barracks. Fine."

Instead, Robert was ushered into the Landstuhl Fisher House where he was able to get food as he went to and from the hospital, a safe place to stay near August, and comfort.

"I felt like I was surrounded by family because everyone else in there was dealing with something like this. Right? So when I passed someone in the hall, the conversation felt very natural. It wasn't like talking to a random stranger. I knew the person that I was engaging with in the hall that day or at the kitchen, or who was offering me some dinner that they had just made, I knew that they were there for the same purpose that I was, that there was an injured family member in the hospital.

SCHOLARSHIP CASH CALL



Fisher House Foundation, Inc., an IRS recognized 501(c)(3) charity, administers the Scholarships for Military Children program. Commissary business partners and others donate to Fisher House Foundation, Inc., which treats each contribution as a "restricted donation." Fisher House Foundation, in turn, contracts with "Scholarship Managers," a professional scholarship management firm, to evaluate the applications and select the best qualified as recipients.

Every dollar received is given out as a scholarship grant. Additionally, Fisher House Foundation matches all donations, dollar for dollar, and does not charge for its services, to include the costs of administration and the cost of the scholarship management contract. For school year 2023-24, there will be 500 recipients selected, and each will receive a \$2,000 scholarship grant.



MEET A SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MILITARY CHILDREN GRANT RECIPIENT

Shortly after Noelle Nafus was born in December 2001, her dad, Marine Corps Col. Matthew Nafus, was deployed twice, once to Pearl Harbor for a year and then to Iraq for a year. During her senior year of high school, her dad was called to active duty twice more. As the Marine Emergency Preparedness Liaison Officer for New York, New Jersey, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands, he was first called up to help with the COVID-19 crisis and again for the 2020 hurricane season.



Noelle is one of 500 recipients of the Fisher House

Foundation's Scholarships for Military Children scholarship grant. The program, designed for kids just like her, is in its 20th year supporting children of military service members and veterans and is administered in partnership with the Defense Commissary Agency. Each awardee receives a \$2,000 scholarship.

Noelle will attend Barnard College of Columbia University in New York.

"It means a lot. Any help I can receive, I'm so grateful for," said Noelle. "This is definitely going to help me."

"I'm super excited to get involved on the Columbia campus and I was thinking about joining the Columbia Daily Spectator, which is the newspaper," she said. "I love to sing so I was hoping to get involved in some choirs and a cappella groups and different things like that."

"I'm really proud of him," said Noelle of her dad. "I don't remember what it was like for him to be on active duty, so this was really the first time for me. It's hard, because I miss him, but I'm so proud of him for helping out in any way he can."

"I'm just so happy to have this opportunity and definitely the scholarship to go to my dream school," said Noelle.
