### THE FISHER HOUSE FOUNDATION



A Fisher House is "a home away from home" for families of patients receiving medical care at major military and VA medical centers. The homes are normally located within walking distance of the treatment facility or have transportation available. There are Fisher Houses located on 15 military installations and 44 VA medical centers. Many more houses are under construction or in design. Typically, the houses are 5,000 to 16,800 square foot homes donated by the Fisher family and Fisher House Foundation. Each house is designed to provide up to 21 suites. All are professionally furnished and decorated in the tone and style of the local region. The houses can accommodate 16 to 42 family members. They feature a common kitchen, laundry facilities, spacious dining room and an inviting living room with library and toys for children. Newest houses are 100% handicap accessible and include elevators. A Fisher House is a temporary residence and is not a treatment facility, hospice, or counseling center.

Fisher House Foundation ensures that there is never a lodging fee. Since inception, the program has saved military and veterans' families an estimated \$610 million in out-of-pocket costs for lodging and transportation. Over 500,000 families have stayed at a Fisher House since its inception in 1990, and that number continues to grow each year as Fisher House Foundation builds new houses at VA and military medical centers with the greatest need.

## THE FISHER HOUSE FOUNDATION

Fisher House Foundation also operates the Hero Miles program, using donated frequent flyer miles to bring family members to the bedside of injured service members. Thanks to your generosity, we have provided more than 70,000 tickets to wounded, injured, and ill service members and their families, worth over \$105 million. The Hotels for Heroes program uses donated hotel points to allow family members to stay at hotels near medical centers without charge. The Foundation also manages a grant program that supports other military charities and scholarship funds for military children, spouses, and children of fallen and disabled veterans with over \$27 million awarded to date.

## FISHER HOUSE IMPACT

Vietnam veteran and wife reflect on 11 years of Fisher

**House**—Harry Richardson, an Army Vietnam Veteran, and his wife Karen have seen a lot of life together in 40 years of marriage. They've visited the West Palm Beach VA Fisher House off and on for the last 11 years. Most recently, they beat Harry's cancer together and are looking forward to many more years together.

"The Fisher House is just truly a blessing," Karen said.

Harry experienced Agent Orange exposure in Vietnam, and he'd heard for years about how it affected other veterans. When Harry was diagnosed with cancer, Karen knew she wanted to be by his side for treatment.

"We've been married 40 years, and as a spouse, I want to be here for my husband and always will be.

With the long commute from their home to the West Palm Beach VA Medical Center, the Fisher House has saved them a lot of time and money.

"The drive is an hour and a half," Harry said. "Having the Fisher House has saved us money on gas, on wear and tear on our cars. That's probably saved us thousands of dollars in vehicles, including tires. It saved us so much. And plus our time spent. I mean that gives us more time together and more time with our family there in Lewiston."

"Obviously staying at the Fisher House for over 11 years," she said, "We've seen a lot of different situations. Loved ones, women losing their spouse, little ones needing care, just anything and everything you can imagine of diseases and illnesses of different types of care and different levels."

"It is just a lot of camaraderie here. Being at the Fisher House is like being with family," she said. "Everybody sits in the dining room and talks or we sit out here and talk. You find something common with everybody we meet, but it's always been that way here. They're like family to us. They're like our family and we just love them."

## FISHER HOUSE IMPACT

Peace at Fisher House—Lupe Nimetullahlah served as a supply sergeant in Germany and at Fort Liberty (formerly Fort Bragg), North Carolina. She cared for her fellow soldiers and her two children over the course of her career. When her adult daughter, Lakeisha (Keisha) Samilton suddenly required a heart transplant, she found herself in the caregiver role again.

In 2020, Keisha was diagnosed with sarcoidosis of the heart and the lungs, but it wasn't until 2023 that she suddenly felt ill and was medically evacuated from the hospital near her home in Hampton, Virginia to Northern Virginia.

Lupe traveled to be with her daughter who was barely functioning on 10% of her heart. Keisha spent the next three weeks on ECMO until she could receive a heart transplant. Following the transplant, she was in a coma for three days. At first, Lupe stayed in hotels, but she soon realized they would need a longer-term solution and sought a small apartment. The costs were incredibly high and nearly impossible to sustain.

Fortunately, Lupe was connected to a social worker who told her about the Fort Belvoir Army Fisher House at Fort Belvoir, Virginia.

"She showed me this place here, and I said, wow, I don't believe this. She said, 'everything's free.' I said, 'no, everything's not free. Come on now. Ain't nowhere free, and she said, 'everything's free.' She showed me around. It just felt like a burden lifted up off of me. It was amazing. This is amazing place."

After Keisha was released from the hospital in May, she required many follow-up appointments and at one point was readmitted, so the Fisher House provided again a home away from home for the mother daughter duo/team. Keisha shared how important it has been to have her mom nearby.

"It means everything. I couldn't do any of this. I'm so thankful that she's here," said Keisha. "Her being here takes a load off of me too. Fisher House means a lot. It allows us to be here and connect and things like that. But her being here is everything."

## SCHOLARSHIP CASH CALL

Fisher House Foundation, Inc., an IRS recognized 501(c)(3) charity, administers the Scholarships for Military Children program. Commissary business partners and others donate to Fisher House Foundation, Inc., which treats each contribution as a "restricted donation." Fisher House Foundation, in turn, contracts with "Scholarship Managers," a professional scholarship management firm, to evaluate the applications and select the best qualified as recipients.

Every dollar received is given out as a scholarship grant. Additionally, Fisher House Foundation matches all donations, dollar for dollar, and does not charge for its services, to include the costs of administration and the cost of the scholarship management contract. For school year 2024-25, there will be 500 recipients selected, and each will receive a \$2,000 scholarship grant.



#### Pilot in Training Receives Scholarship-Mikaela

Miles has always wanted to fly, and now she flies every day. She starts her days early, but she says that once she is in the air and sees the sunrise, she knows it's all worth it.

As a freshman at one of the top universities for pilots, Embry Riddle Aeronautical University in Daytona Beach, Florida, Mikaela is pursuing a degree in aeronautical science. She hopes to serve in the Air Force upon graduation, but she has her sights set on her long-term goal as well.

"My main goal is definitely to be an airline pilot. I think it's just, like, the coolest job. Flying a plane is just an amazing thing to me," said Mikaela. "Just being able to travel and say, 'I flew a plane there and helped a bunch of people either see their families or go on their vacation. I helped them get to that destination.""

Mikaela and her older sister, Ariana, grew up near San Diego, California, with her mom, Shirl, and her dad, retired Marine Tommie Miles. Tommy retired from the military in 2000, but his service is still impacting his family through Fisher House Foundation's Scholarship for Military Children.

"The scholarship really did mean a lot to me because at first we weren't even sure if I was going to be able to go to the school because it is pretty expensive," she explained. "This was another step to my goals. So yeah, it meant a lot to me."
